# Day 1

*FLIGHT TO DALANZADGAD,  
YOL VALLEY HIKE*

**YOLYN AM IS A DEEP AND NARROW GORGE LOCATED IN THE ZUUN SAIKHAN MOUNTAIN RANGE OF THE GURVAN SAIKHAN MOUNTAINS IN OMNOGOVI PROVINCE. ITS NAME COMES FROM THE MONGOLIAN WORD 'YOL,' MEANING THE BEARDED VULTURE, AND 'YOLYN AM' TRANSLATES TO 'THE GORGE OF THE BEARDED VULTURE.'**



# Day 2

**KHONGOR DUNES  
CAMEL & SUNSET**

**"Khongoryn Els is located within the Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park, at the foot of the Gurvan Saikhan Mountains, with some dunes reaching heights of up to 300 meters. The sand dunes cover an area of 965 square kilometers, stretching 100-180 km in length and 6-12 km in width, situated 180 km from Dalanzadgad."**

# Day 3

## *Nomad interaction & sandboarding*

**"Sandboarding on the sand dunes is just like snowboarding down a mountain, using a board to slide down the golden sands — it is one of the most thrilling and fun activities you can experience in the desert.**

**How to do it:**

- **Climb the dune — reaching heights of 200-300 meters takes approximately 30-60 minutes**
- **Rent a board — boards are available for hire at the base of the dunes**
- **Slide down — fast and exhilarating!**
- **Warning: On windy days, sand can sting your face, so bringing sunglasses or goggles is highly recommended.\*\*\***

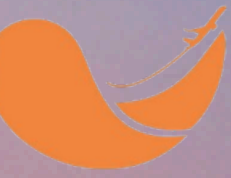


# Day 4

## BAYANZAG FLAMING CLIFFS

"BAYANZAG IS LOCATED 100 KM NORTHWEST OF DALANZADGAD IN OMNOGOVI PROVINCE AND IS PART OF THE GOBI GURVANSAIKHAN NATIONAL PARK. ROY CHAPMAN ANDREWS NAMED THE SITE 'FLAMING CLIFFS' AFTER WATCHING THE RED ROCKS GLOW BRILLIANTLY LIKE FLAMES AT SUNSET. IN MONGOLIAN, IT IS KNOWN AS 'ULAAN EREG,' MEANING 'RED CLIFFS.'"

"Over 100 species of prehistoric animal remains have been discovered at Bayanzag, including petrified forests, remains of some of the largest mammals ever known, and complete dinosaur skeletons — most of which are now on display at the Natural History Museum in Ulaanbaatar. Excavations continue to this day, with new discoveries still being made."
