# Day 1

## *Flight, Bayanzag fossil hunt*

MIAT FLIGHT TAKES ABOUT 1 HOUR. FROM DALANZADGAD, IT'S A DRIVE OUT TO BAYANZAG. AT SUNSET THE RED CLIFFS GLOW AS IF ON FIRE – THE BEST TIME TO PHOTOGRAPH THEM. OVERNIGHT IN A GER CAMP.

"BAYANZAG IS LOCATED 100 KM NORTHWEST OF DALANZADGAD IN OMNOGOVI PROVINCE AND IS PART OF THE GOBI GURVANSAIKHAN NATIONAL PARK. ROY CHAPMAN ANDREWS NAMED THE SITE 'FLAMING CLIFFS' AFTER WATCHING THE RED ROCKS GLOW BRILLIANTLY LIKE FLAMES AT SUNSET. IN MONGOLIAN, IT IS KNOWN AS 'ULAAN EREG,' MEANING 'RED CLIFFS.'"

"Over 100 species of prehistoric animal remains have been discovered at Bayanzag, including petrified forests, remains of some of the largest mammals ever known, and complete dinosaur skeletons – most of which are now on display at the Natural History Museum in Ulaanbaatar. Excavations continue to this day, with new discoveries still being made."

# Day 2

## *Paleontologist-led dig*

**Dig at the fossil site under the guidance of a paleontologist. You'll learn how to identify and document bones and eggs in the field. This is the very ground where the world's first dinosaur egg nest was discovered in 1923. After heavy rain, freshly exposed fossils sometimes emerge right from the rock face.**

# Day 3

## *Khongor Dunes*

**"Khongoryn Els is located within the Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park, at the foot of the Gurvan Saikhan Mountains, with some dunes reaching heights of up to 300 meters. The sand dunes cover an area of 965 square kilometers, stretching 100-180 km in length and 6-12 km in width, situated 180 km from Dalanzadgad."**

# Day 4

## Moltzog Els



**Just 15 minutes from Bayanzag. Smaller than Khongoryn Els but ecologically vital — dense with saxaul trees that anchor the desert soil. Home to camel-herding nomadic families. You can ride a camel across the dunes and stop for tea in a ger. At dusk, the Flaming Cliffs glow on the horizon.**

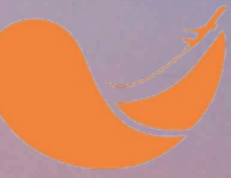


# Day 5

## Yol Valley

**YOL VALLEY — A DEEP GORGE CUTTING THROUGH THE GOBI. ICE LINGERS ON THE FLOOR WELL INTO SUMMER, AND THE TRAIL NARROWS BETWEEN SHEER ROCK WALLS ON BOTH SIDES. BEARDED VULTURES AND IBEX ARE OFTEN SPOTTED ALONG THE WAY.**

**YOLYN AM IS A DEEP AND NARROW GORGE LOCATED IN THE ZUUN SAIKHAN MOUNTAIN RANGE OF THE GURVAN SAIKHAN MOUNTAINS IN OMNOGOVI PROVINCE. ITS NAME COMES FROM THE MONGOLIAN WORD 'YOL,' MEANING THE BEARDED VULTURE, AND 'YOLYN AM' TRANSLATES TO 'THE GORGE OF THE BEARDED VULTURE.'**
