Fly Murun, drive to lake

"KNOWN AS THE 'DARK BLUE PEARL OF MONGOLIA,' LAKE KHUVSGUL IS LOCATED IN KHUVSGUL PROVINCE IN NORTHERN MONGOLIA, NEAR THE BORDER WITH RUSSIA. MONGOLIANS REVERE THE LAKE AS 'DALAI EEJ,' MEANING 'MOTHER OCEAN.' THE LAKE SITS AT AN ELEVATION OF 1,645 METERS ABOVE SEA LEVEL, STRETCHES 136 KM IN LENGTH, AND REACHES A DEPTH OF 262 METERS. IT IS THE SECOND LARGEST FRESHWATER LAKE IN ASIA, HOLDING 70% OF MONGOLIA'S FRESH WATER AND 0.4% OF THE WORLD'S TOTAL FRESH WATER SUPPLY. THE LAKE'S WATER IS TRANSPARENT TO A DEPTH OF 24.5 METERS AND IS DRINKABLE WITHOUT ANY TREATMENT — MAKING IT ONE OF THE CLEAREST FRESHWATER LAKES IN THE WORLD."

"The History of Mongolian Shamanism
Mongolian Shamanism has a history of over 3,000 years and is one of the oldest spiritual traditions in the world. It is not based on belief in a specific god, but rather on animism — the belief that all living and non-living things possess a spirit. A shaman is known in Mongolian as 'Böö' and serves as an intermediary between the human world and the spirit world. They have the ability to perform healing rituals, foretell the future, and seek protection. Becoming a shaman typically begins with a spiritual calling and learning under the guidance of an elder mentor."**

Forest hiking, reindeer visit



"The taiga forests along the shores of Lake Khuvsgul are a breathtaking natural landscape covered in Siberian pine and cedar trees.

The most distinctive highlight of the Lake Khuvsgul region is the Tsaatan, or reindeer herders — this group of Tuvan ethnic origin is one of the rarest and most mysterious nomadic peoples in the world.

What to do when meeting the Tsaatan:

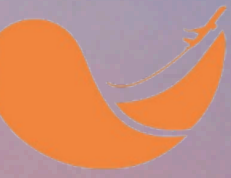
Interact with the reindeer — feed and ride the reindeer
