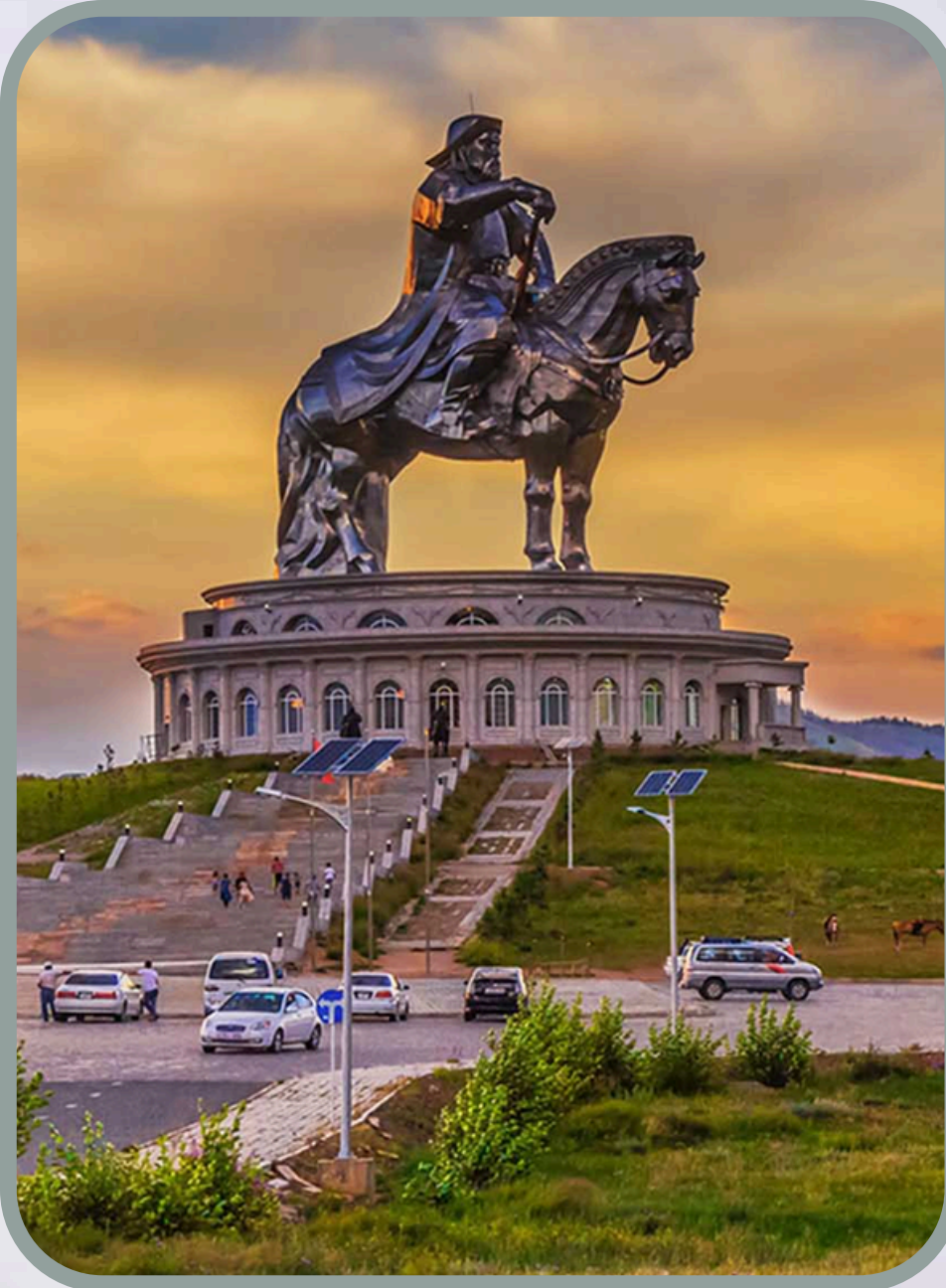

Chinggis Khan Statue



Chinggis Khan Statue Complex: 40m stainless steel equestrian statue.



The complex holds two Guinness World Records — the tallest equestrian statue (40m) and the tallest boot (9m).



"This enormous traditional Mongolian boot is officially recognized by the Guinness World Records as the largest boot in the world, standing at an impressive 9 meters tall."

Turtle Rock

Aryabal Meditation Temple



Hidden in a mountain valley near Turtle Rock, 56 km from Ulaanbaatar, this temple is located within the Gorkhi-Terelj National Park. Aryabal is a Buddhist deity who listens to all the prayers of humankind and releases them from suffering. The temple was built in the shape of an elephant's head."



Ger Lunch

Enjoying a traditional Mongolian meal inside a nomad's ger is one of the most memorable parts of the journey. Guests are typically served the following dishes:

- Tsuivan — stir-fried noodles with meat
- Banshtai shul — soup with dumplings
- Tsai — traditional milk tea
- Khorkhog — meat cooked with hot stones (on special occasions)

It is a unique opportunity to visit inside a traditional ger, meet a nomadic family, and experience Mongolian way of life firsthand."



Horse Riding

Riding through the vast open landscapes of Terelj is one of the most popular activities among visitors to Mongolia. Rides are available from approximately 30 minutes up to 2 hours. The Mongolian horse is small in size but incredibly resilient and reliable."
