Terelj & UB

1. SUKHBAATAR SQUARE LOCATED IN THE HEART OF ULAANBAATAR, SUKHBAATAR SQUARE IS THE CULTURAL AND HISTORICAL CENTER OF THE CITY. THE STATE PALACE AND STATUES OF MONGOLIAN HEROES REFLECT THE NATION'S IDENTITY, AND NUMEROUS EVENTS AND CELEBRATIONS ARE HELD HERE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.
2. BOGD KHAN WINTER PALACE THE BOGD KHAN WINTER PALACE MUSEUM, ONCE HOME TO MONGOLIA'S LAST KING, HOUSES RARE ARTIFACTS, RELIGIOUS RELICS, AND THE KING'S PERSONAL BELONGINGS. WALKING THROUGH ITS ORNATELY DECORATED HALLS OFFERS A VIVID GLIMPSE INTO THE COUNTRY'S POLITICAL AND CULTURAL PAST.
3. NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM HERE YOU CAN SEE DINOSAUR SKELETONS, INCLUDING A COMPLETE TARBOSAURUS DISCOVERED IN THE GOBI DESERT, AS WELL AS EXHIBITIONS SHOWCASING MONGOLIA'S RICH NATURAL HERITAGE.

"ULAANBAATAR IS THE CAPITAL OF MONGOLIA, A CITY WHERE MODERN CULTURE AND ANCIENT TRADITION BLEND TOGETHER IN A REMARKABLE WAY. FOUNDED IN THE 17TH CENTURY, THIS CITY IS HOME TO APPROXIMATELY 45% OF THE COUNTRY'S ENTIRE POPULATION AND, WHILE STILL BEARING TRACES OF THE SOVIET ERA, IS RAPIDLY CHANGING AND DEVELOPING."



Day 3-6

GOBI DESERT FLIGHT

"Khongoryn Els is located within the Gobi Gurvansaikhan National Park, at the foot of the Gurvan Saikhan Mountains, with some dunes reaching heights of up to 300 meters. The sand dunes cover an area of 965 square kilometers, stretching 100-180 km in length and 6-12 km in width, situated 180 km from Dalanzadgad."

Day 7-9

Karakorum & Orkhon

"CAPITAL OF THE MONGOL EMPIRE LOCATED IN ÖVÖRKHANGAI PROVINCE, KARAKORUM WAS THE CAPITAL OF THE MONGOL EMPIRE. FOUNDED BY GENGHIS KHAN, THIS CITY FLOURISHED AS A POLITICAL AND CULTURAL CENTER, STRATEGICALLY POSITIONED AT THE CROSSROADS OF ANCIENT TRADE ROUTES. IN 1260, KUBLAI KHAN MOVED THE CAPITAL TO BEIJING, AND IN 1388, THE ARMIES OF THE MING DYNASTY DESTROYED KARAKORUM. OF THE CITY'S FORMER GLORY, ALL THAT REMAINS TODAY ARE THE TURTLE-SHAPED STONE MONUMENTS THAT ONCE GUARDED THE CITY GATES."**

RESEARCH HAS REVEALED THAT DURING THE 13TH CENTURY, KARAKORUM SERVED AS A CONNECTING HUB OF WORLD CIVILIZATION, ATTRACTING TRAVELERS, OFFICIALS, NOBLES, AND SCHOLARS FROM ACROSS ASIA, EUROPE, AND THE ARAB WORLD. THE CITY WAS DESTROYED BY WAR IN 1380. IN 1586, THE ERDENE ZUU MONASTERY WAS ESTABLISHED ON THE GROUNDS OF THE FORMER CITY.



Day 10-11

Elsen Tasarkhai & Khustai



"FUN FACT: THERE ARE ONLY ABOUT 30 PLACES IN THE ENTIRE WORLD WHERE SINGING SAND DUNES EXIST, AND MONGOLIA'S ARE AMONG THE MOST FAMOUS OF THEM ALL!"

ELSEN TASARKHAI IS LOCATED 280 KM WEST OF ULAANBAATAR AND 80 KM EAST OF KARAKORUM, AND ITS NAME TRANSLATES FROM MONGOLIAN AS 'AN ISOLATED TORN-OFF PIECE OF SAND.' LOCAL PEOPLE CALL IT 'DUUT MANKHAN,' MEANING 'SINGING SAND.' THE NAME 'DUUT MANKHAN' IS CONNECTED TO A RARE NATURAL PHENOMENON — WHEN WIND SWEEPS ACROSS THE SURFACE OF THE SAND, OR WHEN DRY SAND CASCADES DOWN THE SLOPES, THE DUNES PRODUCE A LOW, VIBRATING SOUND."

Day 10-11

Khustai National Park Wildlife Safari

THE PARK IS HOME TO 55 SPECIES OF MAMMALS, 223 SPECIES OF BIRDS, 2 AMPHIBIANS, 4 REPTILES, 15 FISH, AND OVER 500 INSECT SPECIES. MANY OF THESE ARE LISTED AS ENDANGERED.

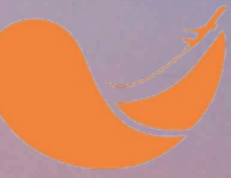
KEY WILDLIFE: BEYOND THE FAMOUS PRZEWALSKI'S HORSES, THE PARK IS ALSO HOME TO RED DEER, MONGOLIAN GAZELLES, MARMOTS, FOXES, AND WOLVES.

BIRD HIGHLIGHTS: BIRDWATCHERS CAN SPOT OVER 200 SPECIES INCLUDING GOLDEN EAGLES, STEPPE EAGLES, CINEREOUS VULTURES, MONGOLIAN LARKS, AND THE RARE WHITE-NAPED CRANE.

BEST TIME TO VIEW: WILDLIFE WATCHING IS BEST AT DAWN AND DUSK, SO SPENDING AT LEAST ONE NIGHT IN THE PARK IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

SAFARI TIP: LOOK OUT FOR PARK RANGERS STATIONED WITH TELESCOPES — THEY ARE ALWAYS POSITIONED NEAR AREAS WHERE ANIMALS CAN BE SPOTTED.**
